1. Personal data that we process

Black Sand Diving process your personal data by using our services and / or by providing this information to us via our registration form (online and/or in-person)

Our website and / or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are younger than 16 years unless they have permission from parents or guardians. However, we cannot check if a visitor is older than 16 and we actively encourage parents to be involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. 1.1 Photo and video material

During our activities, some imaging such as the taking of photos and videos could occur. These are for the purpose of showcasing our activities on social media, such as Facebook, Instagram, Google applications, Twitter and Youtube. Consent for the use of these images are explicitly given or denied as part of the registration process.

2. For what purpose do we collect and store personal data

Black Sand Diving process your personal data for the following purposes:

Your personal safety. Water based activities are inherently dangerous and the collecting of certain medical data enables us to advise you of any risks that could preclude you from taking part in the activity.

Personalised service. The personal data, dive data and all other information that you have entered in our application form are only intended to provide the best possible service and are only used for the following purposes:

Correct sizing of equipment for follow-up activities.

Phone numbers for general communication and notification of last-minute changes (such as agreed meeting times & location)

E-mail for general communication & marketing (opt out is available for marketing material at any time)

Personal data required for providing access to online learning platforms and processing of PADI programs and experiences offered.

3. Sharing personal data with third parties

Black Sand Diving only provides personal data to the following third parties.

PADI EMEA (relevant data only) – we make extensive use of the online learning platform and some personal data is required to gaining access to course material. The same information is also used for tracking progress and processing certifications for completed PADI programs and courses.

DAN Europe (relevant data only) – it is a legal requirement in Spain for divers to have bespoke accident cover to participate in scuba diving activities. In the absence of a diver having their own insurance, cover can be purchased through Black Sand Diving as a Short-term Partner of DAN Europe. This purchase will require the sharing of some personal data with DAN Europe and the underwriter.

4. Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

Black Sand Diving uses only technical and functional cookies and analytical cookies that do not infringe your privacy. A cookie is a small text file that is stored on your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. The cookies we use are necessary for the technical operation of the website and your ease of use. They ensure that the website works properly and remember, for example, your preferences. We can also optimize our website with this. You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it does not store cookies anymore. In addition, you can also delete all information previously saved via the settings of your browser.

5. View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by Atlantiq Science S.L. and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal information we hold to you or another organization mentioned by you in a computer file.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for withdrawal of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your Photo ID with the request. Make sure the document number and/or machine-readable zone (the strip with numbers at the bottom of the document), is redacted in this copy. This is to protect your privacy. We respond as quickly as possible, but within four weeks, at your request.

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7. How long we store personal data

Atlantiq Science S.L. does not store your personal data longer than is strictly necessary to realize the purposes for which your data is collected. We use the following retention periods for the following (categories) of personal data:

PADI requires us to keep personal data and data relating to courses for at least 7 years. Anyone who follows a PADI course with us cannot come under this obligation.

For everyone who comes to dive with us there is no reason to keep the data longer than necessary. To keep the quality of our service as high as possible, we keep your data as long as possible. The paper version is destroyed after 12 months, the digital version is blocked after a period of inactivity of 5 years.
